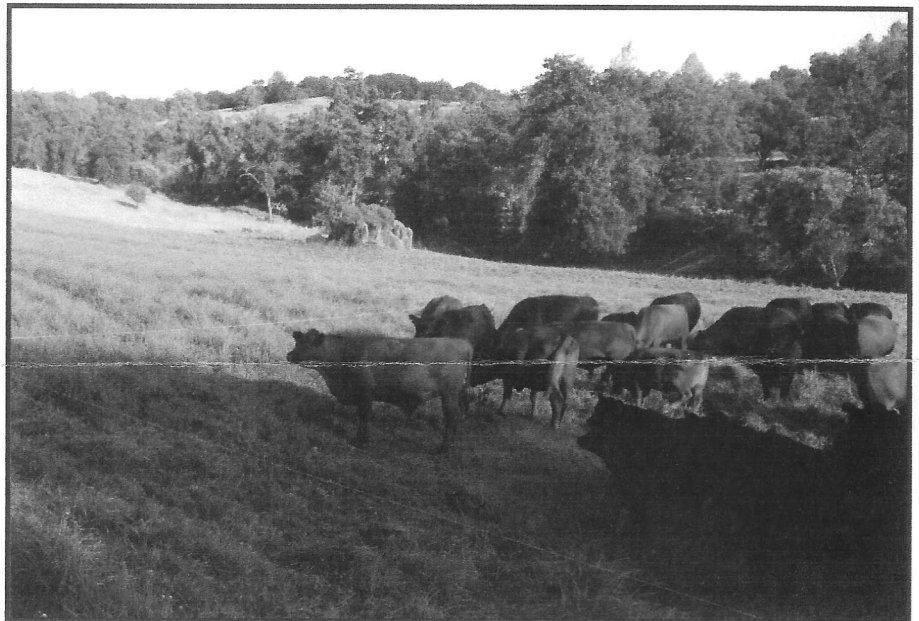
Learn how to maintain your pasture and improve water management and system efficiency. This workshop features indoor and outdoor presentations.
